GIVING WHEN IT COUNTS

Over the course of more than fifteen years, the Alaska USA Foundation has distributed more than \$2.5 million in support to organizations with programs that benefit children, veterans, active duty military and their families, and local food banks and pantries. With the credit union's assistance, in 2020, the Foundation was able to contribute 99.7% of its total income with contributions totaling \$416,605. The Alaska USA Foundation is privileged to help fund organizations in Alaska, Arizona, California, and Washington.

ACTIVE DUTY MILITARY & THEIR FAMILIES

The Alaska USA Foundation donated \$65,000 this year, to help provide a network of support for military individuals and their families. We are proud to support those who defend our nation.

CHILDREN

Nonprofits that perform a range of services for children, including medical care, food programs, head-start programs, and financial education received \$125,500 this year.

VETERANS

The Alaska USA Foundation assisted agencies that work to prevent homelessness, help veterans to obtain necessary medical services, and provide legal aid assistance by giving \$25,000 to veteran support groups this year.

FOOD BANKS & PANTRIES

Now, more than ever, hunger is one of the most prominent issues in all of the communities we serve. As such, Alaska USA Foundation was able to distribute a record amount of \$93,500 to local food banks and pantries.

This year has been extremely challenging due to the COVID-19 pandemic and we are thankful that at a time when our partners needed us most, we could be there to help.
